

EADC INTENSIVE SUPERVISION PLAN OPTIONS

For those needing extra support and structure, especially those awaiting access to residential treatment

Plan is to be tailored to the individual. This is not a “package” where all apply.

- Daily check-in between PO/counselor Mon-Fri
- Use of Day Reporting at the DMC and/or regular contact with Provoking Hope.
- Daily meeting attendance with the extended documentation form
- More frequent SHRG attendance, perhaps every day.
- Use of sponsor and/or Provoking Hope Mentor
- Clean and sober housing, if available
- More restrictive curfew
- Use of peer support (peers who are stable and are phase III+)
- Possible availability of YCCDP counselors who are in office on Saturday
- Use of family support for ‘house arrest’ or monitoring, if available
- Volunteer work at agencies with structure/support
