4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY  
 5 FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 1983, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF  
 6 SECURITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, INCLUDING GUARD TOWERS AND  
 7 FENCING, AT THE MONTANA STATE PRISON; AND PROVIDING AN  
 8 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9  
 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Definitions. For the purposes of this act,  
 12 unless otherwise stated, the following definitions apply:

13 (1) "Capital project" means acquisition of land or  
 14 improvements, planning, capital construction, renovation,  
 15 furnishing, or major repair projects authorized in this act.

16 (2) "BPICA" means account number 06142 in the bond  
 17 proceeds and insurance clearance fund; "FPRA" means federal  
 18 and private revenue account; "ERA" means earmarked revenue  
 19 account; and "other appropriated funds" means money other  
 20 than general fund or BPICA money that accrues under  
 21 provisions of law to an agency indicated herein.

22 (3) "Approved budget amendment" means approval by the  
 23 budget director of a request submitted through the  
 24 architecture and engineering division of the department of  
 25 administration to transfer excess funds appropriated to a

1 capital project within that agency or to obtain financing to  
 2 expand a project with funds that were not available for  
 3 consideration by the legislature.

4 Section 2. Expansion required to be authorized. No  
 5 existing capital project may be expanded beyond the scope of  
 6 the project as approved by the 47th legislature unless the  
 7 capital project expansion is authorized by an approved  
 8 budget amendment.

9 Section 3. Severability. If a part of this act is  
 10 invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid  
 11 part remain in effect. If a part of this act is invalid in  
 12 one or more of its applications, the part remains in effect  
 13 in all valid applications that are severable from the  
 14 invalid applications.

15 Section 4. Total not appropriation. The total shown in  
 16 this act is for informational purposes only and is not an  
 17 appropriation.

18 Section 5. General fund appropriation. There is  
 19 appropriated from the general fund to account number 06142  
 20 in the bond proceeds and insurance clearance fund \$698,000  
 21 to be used to support the project provided for in [section  
 22 6].

23 Section 6. Prison security construction appropriation.  
 24 The following money is appropriated from the bond proceeds  
 25 and insurance clearance fund to the director of the

1 department of administration:  
2 MONTANA STATE PRISON  
3 Additional security fencing \$390,000  
4 Two guard towers with catwalks 258,000  
5 Guard tower with catwalk on prison 50,000  
6 administration building  
7  
8 TOTAL MONTANA STATE PRISON \$698,000  
9 Section 7. Effective date. This act is effective on  
10 passage and approval.

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
