INTRODUCED BY *Allen Brand Boylan*

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO CONTRACT, WITHIN EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS, WITH AN INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT TO PREPARE AN ESTIMATE OF THE COSTS OF RENOVATING THE OLD MONTANA STATE PRISON; REQUIRING THE COUNCIL TO SUBMIT THE REPORT TO THE 48TH LEGISLATURE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Capital repairs to old prison -- cost estimate. (1) The legislative council shall, within existing appropriations, contract with an independent consultant to prepare a report estimating the costs of capital repairs necessary to enable the old Montana state prison, built in 1870, to be used for incarcerating maximum security inmates.

(2) The report must be prepared by December 1, 1982, and the legislative council shall submit the report to the 48th legislature.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
