- (a) are employed in ranch or agricultural industry programs; and
- (b) have demonstrated sufficient reliability and 18 19 trustworthiness.
  - (2) Housing units outside the confines of the prison fence may be created by renovation of existing buildings or by the erection of new modular-type units. Whenever inmates with adequate skills are available, the department is encouraged to use such inmates in establishing these housing units if an existing collective bargaining unit does not

- prohibit inmate production.
