12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Appropriation. Section 19, Division D,
 14 department of institutions, Montana state prison, Item 1,
 15 general operations, House Bill No. 500, Laws of 1981, as
 16 amended by House Bill No. 2, Laws of 1981, First Special
 17 Session, is amended to increase to \$7,100,174 from
 18 \$7,035,842 the appropriation from the general fund for
 19 fiscal year 1983.

20 Section 2. Purpose. This increase in appropriation is
 21 intended to provide \$64,332 to add a remedial mathematics
 22 teacher, a remedial English teacher, and a special education
 23 teacher to the staff of the academic program at Montana
 24 state prison.
