9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Appropriation -- design of comprehensive  
11 program. (1) There is appropriated \$30,500 from the general  
12 fund to the office of the superintendent of public  
13 instruction for fiscal year 1983 for the purpose of  
14 designing a comprehensive education program for the Montana  
15 state prison.

16 (2) This appropriation is intended to allow the office  
17 of the superintendent of public instruction to design a  
18 comprehensive education program for the prison by:

19 (a) evaluating and assessing the educational  
20 achievement levels of the current inmate population;
