11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Appropriation -- purpose -- reversion. (1)
 13 Section 19, Division D, Department of Institutions, Montana
 14 State Prison, Item 1, General Operations, House Bill No.
 15 500, Laws of 1981, as amended by House Bill No. 2, Laws of
 16 1981, First Special Session, is amended to increase the
 17 fiscal year 1983 general fund appropriation from \$7,035,842
 18 to \$7,319,568.

19 (2) The increase provided in subsection (1) must be
 20 used to provide facilities, supplies, and additional staff
 21 for the inmate treatment programs conducted at the Montana
 22 state prison, including four unit counselors, four addictive
 23 disease counselors, two psychologists, and one counselor
 24 with expertise in the treatment of sexual offenders.

1 (3) Any of the increase in the appropriation provided
 2 in subsection (1) not expended by June 30, 1983, for the
 3 purpose described in subsection (2) shall revert to the
 4 general fund.
 5 Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective July
