- BILL NO. 23 Special Session 1 2 INTRODUCED BY 3 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO 5 THE DEPARTMENT OF INSTITUTIONS FOR PURPOSES OF CONTRACTING

WITH PRIVATE ENTITIES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF
 THREE PRERELEASE CENTERS; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE
 EFFECTIVE DATE.*

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10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Expenditure limit. Expenditures under this
 act may not exceed appropriations.

13 Section 2. Access to records. No funds appropriated by this act may be expended for any contract, written or oral, 14 15 with a nonstate entity for services to be provided by the 16 nonstate entity to members of the public on behalf of the 17 state unless the contract contains a provision allowing 18 access to such records of the nonstate entity as may be 19 necessary for legislative audit and analysis purposes in 20 determining compliance with the terms of the contract. Each 21 such contract may be unilaterally terminated by the state, and each contract shall provide for unilateral termination 22 by the state upon refusal of the nonstate entity to allow 23 24 access to records necessary to carry out the legislative 25 audit and analysis functions set out in Title 5, chapters 12

1 and 13.

2 Section 3. Severability. If a part of this act is 3 invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid 4 part remain in effect. If a part of this act is invalid in 5 one or more of its applications, the part remains in effect 6 in all valid applications that are severable from the 7 invalid applications.

8 Section 4. Other funds to offset general fund. The governor shall decrease the general fund appropriation of 9 10 the department of institutions by the amount of funds 11 received from other sources in excess of any non-general 12 fund appropriation unless such action is expressly contrary 13 to state or federal law, rule, or contract or the governor certifies that the services to be funded by the additional 14 15 funds are significantly different from those for which the 16 department has received an appropriation.

17 Section 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated from 18 the general fund to the department of institutions for 19 fiscal year 1983 \$593,000 for purposes of contracting with 20 private entities for the establishment and operation of 21 three prerelease centers for inmates of correctional 22 facilities who are approaching parole eligibility or 23 discharge.

24 Section 6. Effective date. This act is effective on
25 passage and approval.
