"37-69-304. Qualifications of applicants for journeyman plumber's license -- restriction on authority. (1) The following requirements shall must be met by applicants for a journeyman plumber's license:

(a) a specific record of 4.5 years' experience in the field of plumbing of a character satisfactory to the board. This experience requirement may be fulfilled by working 4 5 years in a major phase of the plumbing business, verified by time or pay records of actual plumbing experience, or by completing an apprenticeship program meeting the standards set by the department of labor and industry or the United States department of labor, bureau of apprenticeship, or credit towards this experience requirement may be given for time spent attending an accredited trade or other school specializing in training of value in the field of plumbing and approved by the board.
