In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>HB35</u>, <u>as introduced</u>.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A act amending 7-4-2104, MCA, to require the election of a county commissioner be limited to the electorate of that respective commissioner's district.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The cost to implement the act, if any, would be absorbed by the affected county.
- 2. Individual ballots will need to be prepared and distributed to each respective commissioner district.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No state impact.

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

County election administrators may experience logistical problems under terms of the bill because commissioner districts currently are determined by population and geographic area, and are not coterminous with either precinct or school district boundaries. Consequently, precincts would need to be redrawn to avoid overlapping commissioner districts within a single precinct. Counties may incur additional printing/distribution costs to provide multiple ballots to individual precincts.
