4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO EXEMPT PARALEGALS
5 AND LEGAL ASSISTANTS FROM THE REQUIREMENT TO REGISTER AS A
6 PROCESS SERVER; AND AMENDING SECTION 25-1-1101, MCA."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 25-1-1101, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "25-1-1101. Registered process server -- levying
11 officer. (1) Any person who makes more than 10 services of
12 process, as defined in 25-3-101, within this state during 1
13 calendar year shall file a verified certificate of
14 registration as a process server with the clerk of the
15 district court of the county in which he resides or has his
16 principal place of business.

17 (2) This part does not apply to:

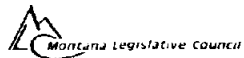
18 (a) a sheriff, constable, coroner, elisor, or other
19 government employee who is acting in the course of his
20 employment; or

21 (b) a licensed attorney; or

22 (c) a paralegal or legal assistant as defined in
23 37-60-101.

24 (3) A registered process server may act as a levying
25 officer under Title 25, chapter 13."
