11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Article V, section 9, of The Constitution of
the State of Montana is amended to read:

14 "Section 9. Disgualification. (1) No member of the 15 legislature shall, during the term for which he shall have 16 been elected, be appointed to any civil office under the 17 state; and no member of congress, or other person holding an 18 office (except notary public, or the militia) under the 19 United St. es or this state, shall be a member of the 19 legislature during his continuance in office.

21 (2) A legislator may not serve more than 8 consecutive 22 years in either the senate or the house of representatives." 23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Applicability. [Section 1] 24 applies to legislative terms that begin during or after 25 January 1993. NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. If approved by
 the electorate, [sections 1 and 2] are effective January 1,
 1993.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. This
amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors of
Montana at the general election to be held in November 1992
by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the
following:
