4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO GENERALLY REVISE THE
5 MEMBERSHIP AND DUTIES OF COUNTY MUSEUM BOARDS; ALLOWING
6 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO APPOINT FIVE MEMBERS TO A MUSEUM
7 BOARD; LIMITING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF A MUSEUM BOARD
8 TRUSTEE; REQUIRING A MUSEUM BOARD TO PRESENT A FINANCIAL
9 REPORT TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS BY JUNE 10 OF EACH YEAR;
10 AMENDING SECTIONS 7-16-2203 AND 7-16-2204, MCA; AND
11 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 **Section 1.** Section 7-16-2203, MCA, is amended to read:

15 "7-16-2203. Board of trustees -- appointment and term
16 -- limitation on term. (1) The board of county commissioners
17 of each county owning or acquiring a museum, facility for
18 the arts, or collection of exhibits may, at the first
19 regular meeting of the board after acquiring a museum,
20 facility, or collection, appoint a board of trustees for the
21 administration of the county museum fund as provided in this
22 part.

23 (2) The board consists of ~~three~~ five responsible
24 persons, electors and residents of the county. The initial
25 terms of members must be staggered, with the term of one of

1 the members expiring on June 30 of the next year, the term
2 of the second member expiring on June 30 of the second year,
3 ~~and the term of the third member expiring on June 30 of the~~
4 ~~third year, the term of the fourth member expiring on June~~
5 ~~30 of the fourth year, and the term of the fifth member~~
6 ~~expiring on June 30 of the fifth year.~~ The board shall, at
7 its regular meeting in July of each year, appoint a member
8 to the board of trustees to take the place of the member
9 whose term expired on June 30 immediately preceding.

10 (3) A member may not serve more than two full terms in
11 succession."

13 "7-16-2204. Role of board of trustees. It is the duty
14 of the board:

15 (1) to have the immediate custody, charge, and control

18 for the preservation, upkeep, care, maintenance, operation,
19 support, and display of the museum, facility, or collection;

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO GENERALLY REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP AND DUTIES OF COUNTY MUSEUM BOARDS; ALLOWING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO APPOINT UP TO FIVE MEMBERS TO A MUSEUM BOARD; LIMITING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF A MUSEUM BOARD TRUSTEE; REQUIRING A MUSEUM BOARD TO PRESENT A FINANCIAL REPORT TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS BY JUNE 10 OF EACH YEAR; AMENDING SECTIONS 7-16-2203 AND 7-16-2204, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-16-2203, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-16-2203. Board of trustees -- appointment and term -- limitation on term. (1) The board of county commissioners of each county owning or acquiring a museum, facility for the arts, or collection of exhibits may, at the first regular meeting of the board after acquiring a museum, facility, or collection, appoint a board of trustees for the administration of the county museum fund as provided in this part.

(2) The board consists MUST CONSIST of three THREE TO FIVE responsible persons, electors and residents of the county. The initial terms of members must be staggered, with

~~the term of one of SO THAT NO FEWER THAN ONE AND NO MORE THAN TWO BOARD MEMBERS COMPLETE A TERM IN ANY 1 YEAR. THE TERM OF EACH BOARD MEMBER IS THEREAFTER 3 YEARS, ENDING ON JUNE 30. A BOARD MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN TWO FULL TERMS IN SUCCESSION. the members expiring on June 30 of the next year, the term of the second member expiring on June 30 of the second year, and the term of the third member expiring on June 30 of the third year, the term of the fourth member expiring on June 30 of the fourth year, and the term of the fifth member expiring on June 30 of the fifth year. The board shall, at its regular meeting in July of each year, appoint a member to the board of trustees to take the place of the member whose term expired on June 30 immediately preceding:~~
