DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This is an act making November and December the 11th and 12th registration periods for motor vehicles; amending 61-3-314, MCA; and providing a delayed effective date, an applicability date, and a partial termination date.

ASSUMPTIONS:


1. The proposal increases the number of motor vehicle registration periods from ten to twelve but does not affect the length of a registration period, the number of vehicles subject to registration, or the taxes and fees assessed for registration and reregistration.



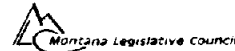
