11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is
13	appropriated from the general fund to the board of public
14	education \$5 million for the biennium ending June 30, 1993,
15	for grants to school districts that are most in need of
16	facility funding to meet the school accreditation standards.
17	(2) The board of public education shall prioritize the
18	award of grants to assist districts that:
19	(a) demonstrate the greatest need for assistance in
20	facility enhancement to meet the accreditation standards;
21	and
22	(b) have taxable wealth per ANB that is below the state
23	average taxable wealth per ANB.
24	(3) Prior to the award of the grant money, the board of
25	public education shall make an advisory report to the

legislative finance committee.
