NEW SECTION. Section 1. Action against successful bidder -- failure to pay unemployment insurance or to carry workers' compensation insurance. A person who loses a competitive bid on a construction contract may maintain an action for damages against a successful bidder if the successful bidder does not contribute to the state unemployment insurance fund, as required by 39-51-1103, or does not pay workers' compensation premiums, as required by 39-71-401.

Insert: "Upon proof that payment by the successful bidder of standard prevailing wages, workers' compensation premiums, and contributions to the state unemployment insurance fund for the job would have increased the successful bidder's bid amount in excess of the plaintiff's bid, the plaintiff may recover damages."
