A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING A LANDOWNER'S

PERMISSION BEFORE HUNTING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY; AND REPEALING SECTION 87-3-304, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Landowner's permission required for hunting. A resident or nonresident shall obtain permission of the landowner, the lessee, or the landowner's or lessee's agents before hunting on private property.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Repealer. Section 87-3-304, MCA, is repealed.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 87, chapter 3, part 1, and the provisions of Title 87, chapter 3, part 1, apply to [section 1].
