In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>HB0176</u>, <u>as introduced</u>.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

The proposed legislation would increase the fee for obtaining certified copies of birth and death certificates and for filing certain instruments required by law to be filed with the county clerk.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Fees charged under 7-4-2631, MCA, which are being amended by this bill are charged and retained by counties.
- 2. Revenue for counties will be increased by \$2 for each certified copy of a birth or death certificate and \$3 for each writ of attachment, execution, certificate of sale, lien, or other instrument required to be filed and indexed. The number of these provided or processed each year on a statewide basis is unknown.
- 3. State agencies may be required by statute to pay these fees; however, it is assumed that the amount of fees paid by state agencies in any given year is minimal.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Impact to state agencies can not be determined, but is assumed to be minimal.

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

The increase in fees will generate revenue increases for all counties relative to the number of documents processed annually.
