BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-5-1027, MCA, is amended to read:

"23-5-1027. Disposition of revenue. (1) A minimum of 45% of the money paid for tickets or chances must be paid out as prize money. The prize money is statutorily appropriated, as provided in 17-7-502, to the lottery.

- (2) Commissions paid to lottery ticket or chance sales agents are not a state lottery operating expense.
- (3) The amount of \$50,000 must be paid each fiscal year from the enterprise fund established by 23-5-1026 to the department of military affairs for the upgrading and maintenance of the state veteran's cemetery established by 10-2-601 and located at Fort William Henry Harrison. This amount is statutorily appropriated, as provided in 17-7-502, to the department of military affairs.
  - (3)(4) That part of all gross revenue not used for the

payment of prizes, commissions, and operating expenses and 2 not appropriated to the department of military affairs under subsection (3), together with the interest earned on the 3 gross revenue while the gross revenue is in the enterprise fund, is net revenue and must be paid quarterly from the fund established by 23-5-1026 to enterprise superintendent of public instruction for distribution as state equalization aid to the public schools of Montana as provided in 20-9-343. The net revenue is statutorily 10 appropriated, as provided in 17-7-502, to the superintendent 11 of public instruction.


