9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 20-1-212, MCA, is amended to read:
11 "20-1-212. Destruction of old records by officer. (1)
12 Unless destruction may be otherwise required by federal law,
13 a school officer may destroy old worthless reports, papers,
14 or records in his office:
15 (a) that have served their purpose and that are
16 substantiated by permanent records, upon the order of the
17 board of trustees ~~and with the approval of the department of~~
18 ~~commerce;~~ and
19 (b) after a retention period of 5 years.
20 (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), old worthless
21 reports, papers, or records do not include student records
22 and records of employment. ~~Such~~ These records or copies of
23 ~~such~~ the records must be permanently kept."
