*19-7-503. Service retirement allowance. (1) The amount of any service retirement allowance granted to a member with 25 years or less of creditable service shall be 2% 2.0834% of his final salary for each year of creditable service, up to a maximum of 50% of final salary.

- (2) The member's retirement allowance shall be increased for any member who contributes after 25 years of service by 1.35% of his final salary for each year of creditable service in excess of 25 years of service, up to a maximum of 60% of his final salary.

STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0288, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act amending 19-7-503, MCA, to increase the retirement allowance for members of the sheriff's retirement system with less than 25 years of creditable service on or after July 1, 1991; and providing an effective and an applicability date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Retirement benefits after July 1, 1991, increase from 2% to 2.0834% of the final average salary (FAS) per year of service up to 25 years or a maximum of 50% FAS. Calculation of death benefits remains unchanged.
- 2. The present funding structure for the retirement system is sufficient to provide the proposed increase without a statutory increase in either employee or employer contribution rates.
- 3. A typical pensioner has an average of 26 years of service and an average pension payment of \$12,432 per year. A typical disability pensioner has an average of 16.75 years of service and an average pension payment of \$8,244 per year.
- 4. The proposed legislation will not impact current cost to administer the retirement system.
- 5. Current law represents the projected number of new pensioners added to the retirement system after July 1, 1991. The retirement system has an annual average of seven individuals who retire on service pensions and four individuals who retire with disability pensions. Service and disability retirements begun in FY92 will be paid an amount equal to the average of six months in the first year and twelve months in the second year of the biennium.

TECHNICAL NOTES:

Currently pensioners with 25 years of service receive the maximum of 50% of the final average salary. The proposed amendment to 19-7-503, MCA, would increase the retirement benefit to 2.0834% but does not change the 50% maximum. Consequently, the proposed legislation does not impact the retirement benefits of pensioners with 25 years or more of creditable service. In order for a pensioner with 25 years of service to receive the proposed benefit increase, the 25 years of creditable service would need to be amended to 24 years. In addition, 19-7-503(2), MCA, would need to be amended to 24 years of creditable service in order for pensioners with more than 25 years to receive the proposed benefit increase.
