4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CREATE THE OFFENSE
5 OF ENTERING OR REMAINING UPON THE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER WITH
6 THE PURPOSE OF AROUSING OR GRATIFYING ONE'S OWN SEXUAL
7 DESIRE BY LOOKING AT AN OCCUPANT OF A STRUCTURE WITHOUT
8 CONSENT."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Entering or remaining upon
12 property of another with the purpose of arousing or
13 gratifying sexual desire. A person who enters or remains
14 upon the property of another and, with the purpose of
15 arousing or gratifying his own sexual desire, looks at an
16 occupant of a structure on the property without consent of
17 the occupant shall, upon conviction of the offense, be fined
18 an amount not to exceed \$1,000 or be imprisoned in the
19 county jail for a term not to exceed 1 year, or both.

20 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction.
21 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part
22 of Title 45, chapter 5, part 5, and the provisions of Title
23 45, chapter 5, part 5, apply to [section 1].
