BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Entering or remaining upon property of another with the purpose of arousing or gratifying sexual desire. A person who enters or remains upon the property of another and, with the purpose of arousing or gratifying his own sexual desire, looks at an occupant of a structure on the property without consent of the occupant shall, upon conviction of the offense, be fined an amount not to exceed \$1,000 or be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 1 year, or both.
