6 BASIS."

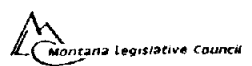

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Montana to remain on mountain
10 standard time. (1) The standard time in the state of Montana
11 and all its political subdivisions is the solar time of the
12 105th meridian west of Greenwich, commonly known as mountain
13 standard time.

14 (2) This section may not be construed to affect the
15 standard time established by United States law governing the
16 movements of common carriers engaged in interstate commerce
17 or the time for performance of an act by an officer or
18 department of the United States, as established by a
19 statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United
20 States or an agency of the United States.

21 (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
22 contrary relating to the adoption of daylight saving time by
23 all of the states, Montana elects to reject daylight saving
24 time and elects to continue in force the terms of subsection
25 (1), relating to standard time in Montana.
