Section 1. Montana to remain on mountain 10 standard time. (1) The standard time in the state of Montana 11 and all its political subdivisions is the solar time of the 12 105th meridian west of Greenwich, commonly known as mountain 13 standard time. 14 (2) This section may not be construed to affect the

standard time established by United States law governing the movements of common carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the time for performance of an act by an officer or department of the United States, as established by a statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United States or an agency of the United States.

(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
contrary relating to the adoption of daylight saving time by
all of the states, Montana elects to reject daylight saving
time and elects to continue in force the terms of subsection
(1), relating to standard time in Montana.
