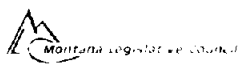
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 **Section 1.** Section 82-15-103, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "**82-15-103. Standards for petroleum products.** (1) The
11 standards and specifications for petroleum products,
12 including but not limited to gasoline, fuel oils, diesel
13 fuel, kerosene, and liquefied petroleum gases, ~~shall~~ must be
14 determined by the department and ~~shall~~ must be based upon
15 nationally recognized standards and specifications ~~such--as~~
16 that are published from time to time by the American society
17 for testing materials. When ~~so-determined-by-the-department~~
18 ~~and~~ adopted as rules, ~~such~~ the standards and specifications
19 are the standards and specifications for ~~such~~ the products
20 sold in this state, and official tests of ~~such~~ the products
21 ~~shall~~ must be based upon them.

22 (2) The department may not establish a minimum standard
23 antiknock (octane) rating number for gasoline lower than
24 87."
