BY REQUEST OF THE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGISTS

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION TO PRACTICE MANICURING AND FOR APPLICANTS TO RECEIVE TEMPORARY LICENSES TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY AND MANICURING; CLARIFYING THE PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF TEMPORARY LICENSES; AMENDING SECTIONS 37-31-304 AND 37-31-307, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 37-31-304, MCA, is amended to read:

"37-31-304. Qualifications of applicants for license to practice. (1) Before a person may practice cosmetology, he must obtain a license to practice cosmetology from the department. Before a person may practice manicuring, he must obtain a license to practice manicuring from the department ~~unless he is licensed to practice cosmetology.~~

(2) (a) To be eligible to take the examination to practice cosmetology, the applicant must be not less than 18 years of age and must be of good moral character, and must have:

(i) completed 2 years of high school or possess the

equivalent of a high school diploma recognized by the superintendent of public instruction; ~~the applicant must~~ have;

(ii) completed a continuous course of study of at least 2,000 hours in a registered beauty school, which course of study has been distributed over a period of not less than 10 months or more than 14 months, and ~~must--have~~ received a diploma from the beauty school; or ~~must-have~~

(iii) completed the course of study in cosmetology prescribed by the board.

(b) A person qualified under subsection (2)(a) shall file with the department a written application to take the examination and shall deposit with the department the required examination fee and pass an examination as to his fitness to practice cosmetology.

(3) (a) To be eligible to take the examination to practice manicuring, an applicant must be not less than 18 years of age, must be of good moral character, and must:

(i) possess a high school diploma, an equivalent of a high school diploma recognized by the superintendent of public instruction, or a certificate of completion from a vocational-technical center program; and

(ii) have completed a course of study prescribed by the board in a registered school of ~~cosmetology or a registered school of~~ manicuring.

5 **Section 2.** Section 37-31-307, MCA, is amended to read:

6 "**37-31-307. Temporary license pending examination. (1)**
7 The board may authorize the department to grant to a
8 graduate of a registered school of:

9 (a) cosmetology of any state, on the payment of the fee
10 prescribed by law, a temporary license authorizing--the
11 graduate to practice cosmetology under the supervision of a
12 licensed cosmetologist in the practice of hairdressing and
13 beauty culture; or

14 (b) manicuring of any state, on the payment of the fee
15 prescribed by law, a temporary license to practice
16 manicuring under the supervision of a licensed manicurist.

17 (2) The temporary licenses provided for in subsection
18 (1) are valid for a period not to exceed more than 90 days
19 or until the results of the next examination is held by the
20 department and-the-results are announced, whichever occurs
21 first. No

22 (3) A temporary license may not be issued except on the
23 presentation by the applicant of a certificate of graduation
24 from such a registered school--A-temporary-license and is
25 not renewable."
