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12	WHEREAS, seven tribally controlled community colleges
13	exist in the State of Montana; and
14	WHEREAS, the tribal community colleges provide a
15	quality, low-cost, and accessible college program to Indian
16	and non-Indian students each year; and
17	WHEREAS, approximately 300 of these students are
18	nonbeneficiary students who do not qualify for financial
19	support through the Bureau of Indian Affairs or under the
20	Tribally Controlled Community College Act; and
21	WHEREAS, the tribal community colleges currently
22	subsidize the costs of providing services to nonbeneficiary
23	students, allowing them to continue their educations at a
24	lower cost to the state; and
25	WHEREAS, without support, tribal community colleges will

not be able to serve nonbeneficiary students without 1 increasing student fees, which may result in students 3 dropping out of college. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents \$500,000 for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, to provide financial assistance to nonbeneficiary students enrolled in tribally controlled community colleges in Montana. 10 (2) An expenditure from this appropriation 11 contingent upon the tribal community college: 12 (a) being accredited or being a candidate 13 accreditation by the Northwest association of schools and 14 colleges; and 15 a state-tribal (b) entering into a contract or 16 17 cooperative agreement, pursuant to Title 18, chapter 11, with the board of regents to provide the board with 18 information relating to eligibility of nonbeneficiary 19 students and documentation on the curriculum to ensure that 20 the content and quality of courses offered by the tribal 21 community college are consistent with the standards adopted 22 by the Montana university system. 23

(3) It is the intent of the legislature that the

appropriation request in subsection (1) be considered an
