10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Medicare assignment. (1) A health care provider may not refuse to accept payment for 11 medicare services on the basis of an assignment, as provided 12 13 in section 1842(b)(3)(B)(ii) of the federal Social Security 14 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395u(b)(3)(B)(ii)), under the terms of which 15 full charge for services is the amount of the the medicare-approved rate for payment of the applicable service 16 plus any deductibles, coinsurance, or copayment required to 17 18 be paid by the medicare beneficiary.

19 (2) For purposes of this section, "health care
20 provider" means a person, firm, corporation, association, or
21 institution that provides goods or services subject to
22 payment or reimbursement under the federal medicare program
23 in accordance with Title XVIII of the federal Social
24 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395, et seq.).

25 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Penalty. A person who violates



the provisions of [section 1] or who knowingly presents or causes to be presented a bill or request for payment of charges to a medicare beneficiary in excess of the amount allowed in [section 1] shall upon conviction be fined not more than \$2,000 or be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 1 year, or both.

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Notice required. Each health 8 care provider shall post a copy of [sections 1 and 2] in a 9 conspicuous area in his place of business as notice to 10 medicare beneficiaries concerning their rights under 11 [sections 1 and 2].

- 12 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Repealer. Section 53-5-901,
- 13 MCA, is repealed.
- 14 NEW SECTION. Section 5. Codification instruction.
- 15 [Sections 1 through 3] are intended to be codified as an
- 16 integral part of Title 30, chapter 14, and the provisions of
- 17 Title 30, chapter 14, apply to [sections 1 through 3].
- 18 NEW SECTION. Section 6. Effective date. [This act] is
- 19 effective July 1, 1991.
