GOVERNOR'S AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 354 (REFERENCE COPY, AS AMENDED) April 24, 1991

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-33-2209, MCA, is amended to read:

***7-33-2209.** Finance of fire control activities. (1) The county governing body is authorized to appropriate funds for the purchase, care, and maintenance of firefighting equipment or for the payment of wages in prevention, detection, and suppression of fires.

(2) If the general fund is budgeted to the full limit, the county governing body may, at any time fixed by law for levy and assessment of taxes, levy a tax at-such-rate-as-in-their-judgment will-be-necessary-to-raise-such-needed-sum,-not-to-exceed of up to 2 mills or at a rate that will raise \$15,000, whichever is higher."

Section 2. Levy against certain properties prohibited. The levy authorized by this part may not be assessed against properties located within the incorporated boundaries of a city or town.

Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 1991.
