BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated to Montana state university from the general fund \$60,000 for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, for providing additional support for applied genetic engineering technology research and development to enhance Montana agricultural products.
