9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-12-2102, MCA, is amended to read: 10 11 "7-12-2102. Authorization-to-create Creation of rural 12 improvement districts. (1) Whenever-the-public-interest-or 13 convenience-may-require Upon receipt of a petition signed by 14 the owners of at least 60% of the property in the proposed 15 district, the board of county commissioners is-hereby 16 authorized-and-empowered-to-order-and shall create a special 17 improvement districts district outside of the limits of an 18 incorporated towns town and-cities or city for the purpose 19 of building, constructing, or acquiring by purchase one or 20 more of the improvements of the kind described in 7-12-4102, 21 in or for the benefit of the special improvement district. 22 The petition must:

23 (a) describe the boundaries of the proposed district;

- 24 (b) describe the proposed improvement; and
- 25 (c) estimate the total cost of the improvement and

## suggest the method of making landowner assessments.

2 (2) The board of county commissioners may, order--and 3 upon receipt of a petition meeting the requirements of subsection (1), create special improvement districts 4 5 covering projects abutting the city limits and include 6 properties inside the city where the rural improvement 7 district abuts and benefits that property. Property owners within the proposed district boundaries inside the city may 8 9 not be included in the rural special improvement district if 10 40% of those property owners protest the creation of the 11 rural special improvement district. The property inside the 12 city must be treated in a similar manner as to improvements, notices, and assessments as the property outside the city 13 14 limits. A joint resolution of the city and county must be 15 passed agreeing to the terms of the rural special 16 improvement district prior to passing the resolution of 17 intention or resolution creating the rural special 18 improvement district. A copy of the resolution of intention 19 and the resolution creating the rural special improvement 20 district must be provided to the city clerk upon the passage 21 of the respective resolutions."
