13 Section 1. Section 53-21-206, MCA, is amended to read: 14 "53-21-206. Availability of services. The services of 15 the department and of the incorporated regional mental 16 health centers are must:

17 (a) be made available without discrimination on the
18 basis of race, color, creed, religion, age, diagnosis,
19 physical or mental impairment, or ability to pay; and

(b) shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act
of 1964 and section 1919 of the Public Health Service Act
(42 U.S.C. 300x-7)."
