A statement of intent is required for this bill because 87-5-204 and 87-5-210 require the fish and game commission to adopt rules regarding certain aspects of the use and breeding of raptors and the sport of falconry. Because the regulation of raptors and the sport of falconry are in large part regulated by federal law and because detailed and precise standards are rapidly changing, the rules must comply with federal law and regulations as adopted or amended from time to time. The legislature recognizes that the commission has the power to determine the extent and nature of measures that control wildlife in Montana and that the commission's expertise makes it the proper forum for addressing the regulation of raptors and the sport of falconry.
