A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW THE STATE tREASURER TO ASSESS COUNTIES AN INTEREST CHARGE FOR THE LATE REMITTANCE OF MONEY COLLECTED BY COUNTY TREASURERS FOR THE StATE, RATHER THAN TO REQUIRE THE ASSESSMENT; AMENDING SECTION 15-1-504, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 15-1-504, MCA, is amended to read:
"15-1-504. Settlement of county treasurer with state treasurer. The county treasurer, between the lst and 20 th days of each month, must shall remit to the state treasurer all moneys money belonging to the state which-were that was collected by such the county treasurer during the preceding month. Sueh The remittance shałt must be accompanied by $a$ detailed report upon sueh a form as that the state treasurer may--preseribe;-and-for-ati-sueh-moneys-by-him-coztected-and not-remitted-by-him-to-the-state-treasurer--within--5--days from--the-time-herein-requiredi-he-shatz-pay-interest-at-the rate- $\boldsymbol{f}- \pm \theta$ \%-per-annum prescribes. The state treasurer may assess counties an interest charge of $10 \%$ a year on all money not remitted within 5 days from the time required by
this section."
NEW SECTION. Section 2. Severability. If a part of [this act] is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of (this act] is invalid in one or more of its applications, the part remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective Juiy 1, 1991.
