BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Prohibition on mining in residential areas — exceptions. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), a person may not engage in opencut mining or operate processing facilities within one-half mile of a residence. However, roads leading to and from an opencut mine or processing facility may be constructed within one-half mile of a residence.

- (2) A person may engage in opencut mining and operate processing facilities within one-half mile of a residence if the owner of that residence consents to the proposed operations in writing.
- 21 (3) The prohibition in subsection (1) does not apply to 22 operations of less than 6 months duration.
