House BILL NO. 486

INTRODUCED BY UNIDENTIFIED

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$125,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 1993, AS A LOAN TO DEVELOP AND SELL A COMMON ACCOUNTING SOFTWARE PACKAGE FOR USE BY MONTANA SCHOOL DISTRICTS; REQUIRING REPAYMENT OF THE LOAN BY JUNE 30, 1995; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the general fund to the office of public instruction for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, \$125,000 to an account in the state special revenue fund, established by 17-2-102, as a loan to develop and sell a common accounting software package for use by Montana school districts. The loan must be repaid to the general fund by June 30, 1995, from proceeds realized from the sale of such software to school districts.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
