

12 Section 1. Section 61-3-304, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-3-304. Previous registration receipt, proof of ownership, and proof of liability insurance to accompany application for registration. (1) The treasurer of any a county shall may not accept any an application for registration or reregistration of any motor vehicle unless such the application be is accompanied by:

- (a) the immediately previous registration receipt issued by the department or an affidavit upon a form prescribed by the department stating under oath that the vehicle had not been operated on the highways of the state during the immediately previous year, except in cases of automobiles not previously licensed in Montana;
