4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A MOTOR
5 VEHICLE MAY NOT BE REGISTERED OR REREGISTERED UNLESS THE
6 APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION IS ACCOMPANIED BY THE PREVIOUS
7 REGISTRATION RECEIPT, PROOF OF OWNERSHIP, AND PROOF OF
8 LIABILITY INSURANCE; AMENDING SECTION 61-3-304, MCA; AND
9 PROVIDING AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 **Section 1.** Section 61-3-304, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "61-3-304. Previous registration receipt, proof of
14 ownership, and proof of liability insurance to accompany
15 application for registration. (1) The treasurer of any a
16 county shall may not accept any an application for
17 registration or reregistration of any motor vehicle unless
18 such the application be is accompanied by:

19 (a) the immediately previous registration receipt
20 issued by the department or an affidavit upon a form
21 prescribed by the department stating under oath that the
22 vehicle had not been operated on the highways of the state
23 during the immediately previous year, except in cases of
24 automobiles not previously licensed in Montana;

25 (b) a copy of the certificate of ownership of the

1 vehicle; and

2 (c) proof of compliance with 61-6-301, as provided in
3 61-6-302.

4 (2) No An application for registration or
5 reregistration of any motor vehicle hereafter need not be
6 verified."

7 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Applicability. [This act]
8 applies to all motor vehicles registered or reregistered on
9 or after January 1, 1992.
