BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9

Section 1. Section 37-51-204, MCA, is amended to read:

- "37-51-204. Educational programs 11 and continuing
- 12 education. (1) The board may, subject to 37-1-101, conduct,
- hold, or assist in conducting or holding real estate 13
- 14 clinics, meetings, courses, or institutes and incur
- 15 necessary expenses in this connection.
- 16 (2) The board may assist libraries and educational
- 17 institutions in sponsoring studies and programs for the
- 18 purpose of raising the standards of the real estate business
- 19 and the competency of licensees.
- 20 (3) The Except as provided in subsection (4), the board
- 21 may prescribe by rule continuing education requirements for
- 22 all licensees, not to exceed 15 classroom or equivalent
- 23 hours in any 2-year period, including proof of conformance,
- 24 but except as provided in 37-51-302 the board may not
- 25 require examination of licensees.



- 1 (4) The board may not prescribe continuing education
- 2 requirements for persons who have been licensed under this
- 3 chapter for 10 years or more."
