 7 REQUIREMENT THAT CHILDREN RECEIVE A MEDICAL EXAMINATION
 8 PRIOR TO ADMISSION TO THE MOUNTAIN VIEW SCHOOL, THE PINE
 9 HILLS SCHOOL, OR OTHER FACILITY UNDER AN ORDER OF COMMITMENT
 10 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES; AMENDING SECTIONS
 11 53-30-203 AND 53-30-209, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE
 12 EFFECTIVE DATE."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15 **Section 1.** Section 53-30-203, MCA, is amended to read:
 16 "53-30-203. Control and management of youth
 17 correctional facilities. The facilities provided for in
 18 53-30-202 shall exercise their functions under the
 19 supervision and general management of the department of
 20 family services. Except where otherwise provided by law, the
 21 department by rules shall establish standards of care, and
 22 policies of admission, transfers, discharge, and aftercare
 23 supervision in order to provide adequate care for children
 24 and adequate service to the courts. Policies of admission
 25 may include criteria for medical examinations required under

1 53-30-209. The department shall develop special programs
 2 within each facility which are adaptable to the particular
 3 needs of its operation."

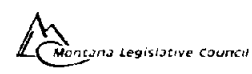
4 **Section 2.** Section 53-30-209, MCA, is amended to read:

5 "53-30-209. Medical examination before commitment
 6 admission -- records required to accompany child committed.
 7 (1) Before a child is committed admitted for any purpose or
 8 for any length of time to the Mountain View school, the Pine
 9 Hills school, or other facility under an order of commitment
 10 to the department of family services, he shall must be
 11 examined by a licensed physician. A child committed to one
 12 of the schools or the department shall must be accompanied
 13 by the order of commitment, a medical examination report, an
 14 adequate social history, and any school records.

15 (2) The medical examination required under this section
 16 must be a current, complete physical examination of the
 17 child."

18 **NEW SECTION. Section 3.** Effective date. [This act] is
 19 effective on passage and approval.

ASSUMPTIONS:


1. The medical service contract for Mountain View School will continue at current level to provide other necessary medical services.
