DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

The bill would allow proceeds from the sale of Department of Justice equipment to be deposited to the credit of the accounting entity from which it was originally purchased, rather than the general fund.

ASSUMPTIONS:


1. In recent years, approval has been obtained to deposit the proceeds from the sale of used Highway Patrol vehicles into the highways special revenue account. Therefore, this bill will not materially impact the state general fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 44-1-106, MCA, is amended to read:

"44-1-106. Authority of department of justice to
dispose of equipment. The department of justice shall have
authority to destroy, sell, or dispose of any and all
obsolete equipment, or uniforms, or parts thereof, ~~and any~~
moneys of obsolete equipment or uniforms. Any money received
therefrom shall from the sale of these items must be paid
deposited into the state general fund treasury in the fund
and to the credit of the accounting entity from which it was
originally purchased."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Effective date. [This act] is
effective July 1, 1991.
