After a victim of a felony offense, as 13 defined in 45-2-101, has received notification of the trial 14 date and sentencing schedule, as provided in 46-24-203, the 15 court shall advise the victim of the possible penalties for 16 a given felony offense. The victim may then make sentencing 17 recommendations to the court before the court pronounces its 18 sentence or otherwise disposes of the case.
