

Section 1. Section 61-3-303, MCA, is amended to read: 10

(1) Every owner of a motor vehicle operated or driven upon the public highways of this state shall for each motor vehicle owned, except as herein otherwise expressly provided, file or cause to be filed in the office of the county treasurer where the owner makes his permanent residence at the time of making the application or, if the vehicle is owned by a corporation or used primarily for commercial purposes, in the taxing jurisdiction of the county where the vehicle is permanently 20 assigned, an application for registration or reregistration 21 upon a blank form to be prepared and furnished by the 22 department. The application shall contain:
