A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING GENERAL FUND--AND FEDERAL MONEY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES FOR THE PURCHASE AND DEVELOPMENT OF A MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM."

STATEMENT OF INTENT

IT IS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, INFORMATION SERVICES DIVISION, PLAN, DESIGN, DEVELOP, AND IMPLEMENT A MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES. THIS INCLUDES THE IMPORTATION OF COMPATIBLE AUTOMATED SYSTEMS SUCCESSFULLY INSTALLED AND OPERATING IN OTHER STATE OR PUBLIC JURISDICTIONS, WHEN POSSIBLE, IF SUCH IMPORTATION IS DETERMINED BY THE INFORMATION SERVICES DIVISION AND DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES TO BE FEASIBLE AND COST-EFFECTIVE.

ADDITIONALLY, IT IS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT THE APPROPRIATION IN THIS BILL BE UTILIZED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANNING, DESIGNING, DEVELOPING, AND IMPLEMENTING THE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM, INCLUDING SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE ACQUISITION. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE DEPARTMENT

OF FAMILY SERVICES WILL ACCESS AND MAXIMIZE USE OF ANY CURRENT AND FORTHCOMING FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR THIS PROJECT. THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES WILL PROVIDE ONGOING PROGRESS REPORTS TO THE LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE REGARDING THE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

AN ACT APPROPRIATING GENERAL FUND AND FEDERAL MONEY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES FOR THE PURCHASE AND DEVELOPMENT OF A MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

It is the intent of the legislature that the department of family services, in conjunction with the department of administration, information services division, plan, design, develop, and implement a management information system for the department of family services. This includes the importation of compatible automated systems successfully installed and operating in other state or public jurisdictions, when possible, if such importation is determined by the information services division and department of family services to be feasible and cost-effective.

Additionally, it is the intent of the legislature that the appropriation in this bill be utilized only for the purpose of planning, designing, developing, and implementing the management information system, including software and hardware acquisition. It is understood that the department of family services will access and maximize use of any current and forthcoming federal funds available for this project. The department of family services will provide ongoing progress reports to the legislative finance committee regarding the management information system.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. Upon final determination of all general fund money in the department of social and rehabilitation services' unreconciled special revenue fund balance and the deposit of these funds in the general fund, the lesser of \$547,339 or the amount available from the balance after funding \$438,795 in fiscal 1992 and \$485,182 in fiscal 1993 appropriated to the department of social and rehabilitation services from the TEAMS project is appropriated from the general fund to the department of family services for the purchase and development of a management information system and may not be used for other purposes. In addition, there is appropriated the following for this purpose:

Fiscal year 1992	\$138,312 from federal special funds
Fiscal year 1993	138,312 from federal special funds
