In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0589, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to change the school district accumulated sick leave reserve fund to the compensated absence liability fund; to include in the fund the accumulated amounts of sick leave and vacation leave for all district employees.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Non-teaching employees receive 12 days sick leave and 15 days annual leave per year.
- 2. Termination liability is 25 percent or accumulated sick leave and 100 percent of annual leave.
- 3. Twenty percent of the districts have reserves at the maximum permissible.
- 4. Twenty five percent of the amount transferred to the Compensated Absence Liability Fund in the districts cited in (3) are replaced with state GTB funds as reserves are transferred to the new fund rather than reappropriated to fund the permissive.
- 5. The amount reserved in FY89 was approximately \$260,000 under current law.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

The state cost of permissive GTB will increase approximately \$100,000 in FY92 only as districts transfer additional funds from the general fund to the compensated absence liability fund.

### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

Districts will increase transfers from general fund to compensated absence liability fund. Some expenditures for accumulated sick and vacation leave will now be paid from compensated absence liability fund rather than general fund.

### TECHNICAL NOTES:

The estimate of fiscal impact contained in this note is speculative as it is based upon incomplete information. After February 15 when FY91 budget data on school districts is available a more refined estimate may become available.

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to change the school district accumulated sick leave reserve fund to the compensated absence liability fund; to include in the fund the accumulated amounts of sick leave and vacation leave for all district employees.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The 1990 level of termination vacation payout will be static into the biennium.
- 2. Districts will phase in the building of reserves to the allowed level over a period of three years as reserves increase from \$800,000 currently to \$3,187,000 by the end of FY94.
- 3. The ratio of reserves to payout experienced for sick leave (27%) will apply to vacation leave.
- 4. Actual costs of sick and vacation termination payout will not increase however transfers to the reserve fund will increase temporarily.
- 5. As funds that would otherwise be available to fund the district permissive are transferred to the reserve fund the cost of state GTB aid is increased by one-third of the amount transferred each year.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

The state cost of permissive GTB will increase approximately \$265,000 in FY92 and \$265,000 in FY93 as districts transfer additional funds from the general fund to the compensated absence liability fund.

### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

Districts will increase transfers from general fund to compensated absence liability fund. Some expenditures for accumulated sick and vacation leave will now be paid from compensated absence liability fund rather than general fund.

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
