A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING INSURERS TO OBTAIN PROOF FROM INSUREDS PRIOR TO ISSUING AN INSURANCE POLICY ON A NEWLY CONSTRUCTED BUILDING OR BUILDING TO BE CONSTRUCTED THAT THE INSUREDS HAVE OBTAINED OR APPLIED FOR REQUIRED CONSTRUCTION PERMITS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Construction permits. An

insurer may not issue a policy of insurance to an insured subject to 50-60-108, for a newly constructed building or a building to be constructed, unless the insured demonstrates that the necessary construction permits have been applied for or obtained.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction.

[Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 33, chapter 24, part 1, and the provisions of Title 33, chapter 24, part 1, apply to [section 1].
