BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Restrictions regarding albino animals -- exceptions. (1) It is unlawful and a misdemeanor for a person to possess, transport, or kill any wild bird, mammal, or fish that exhibits 75% or more white coloration or albino characteristics.

- (2) As used in this section, "albino" means a genetic condition, characterized by a lack of pigmentation that causes feathers, hair, skin, or scales to take on a white or pink coloration, that is found in a wild bird, mammal, or fish.
- (3) The restrictions in subsection (1) do not apply to:
- 22 (a) a swan, goose, ermine, snowshoe hare, jackrabbit, 23 or other wild animal that is naturally white or that changes 24 color with the seasons and does not exhibit any albino
- 25 characteristics; and



(b) animals raised or kept as part of a commercialactivity licensed under Title 87, chapter 4.

3 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction.

4 (Section 1) is intended to be codified as an integral part

of Title 87, chapter 3, part 1, and the provisions of Title

87, chapter 3, part 1, apply to [section 1].
