A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF CRIME CONTROL FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING GRANTS TO ENTITIES INVOLVED IN CRIMESTOPPER AND CRIME PREVENTION PROGRAMS IN THIS STATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Crimestopper and crime prevention programs -- appropriation. (1) The board shall provide grants to private or public entities that the board determines are qualified and involved in promoting, establishing, or operating crimestopper and crime prevention programs in this state.

(2) There must be appropriated each fiscal year from the general fund \$35,000 to the board for the purpose of providing the grants required in subsection (1).

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 44, chapter 4, part 3, and the provisions of Title 44, chapter 4, part 3, apply to [section 1].
