 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

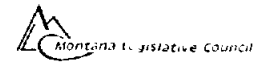
11 **Section 1.** Section 10-3-312, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "10-3-312. Maximum expenditure by governor --
 13 appropriation. (1) Whenever an emergency or disaster is
 14 declared by the governor, there is statutorily appropriated
 15 to the office of the governor, as provided in 17-7-502, and
 16 he is authorized to expend from the general fund, an amount
 17 not to exceed \$2 million in any biennium. In the event of
 18 the recovery of money expended under this section, the
 19 spending authority must be reinstated to a level reflecting
 20 the recovery.

21 (2) If a disaster is declared by the president of the
 22 United States, there is statutorily appropriated to the
 23 office of the governor, as provided in 17-7-502, and he is
 24 authorized to expend from the general fund, an amount not to
 25 exceed \$500,000 during the biennium to meet the state's

1 share of the individual and family grant programs as
 2 provided in 42 U.S.C. 5178."

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0630, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


The bill would require that the emergency or disaster fund be replenished in an amount equal to the amount recovered for expenditures under the disaster and emergency services laws.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The Department of Military Affairs may recover appropriate expenditures under this section of the law.
2. All amounts recovered will be deposited to the general fund in the same manner as under current law.
3. Other agencies may be responsible for recovering expenditures made by the Department of Military Affairs.
4. The bill will have no fiscal impact other than restoring statutory appropriation authority for amounts recovered from other sources.

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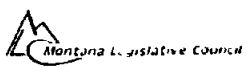

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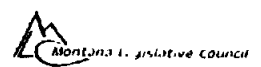
